How we use your personal information







Personal information means information about you like:

- your full name
- your contact details like phone number
- your health information
- where you live
- how old you are.









We collect your personal information when you:

- contact us
- tell us how we are doing
- order something from us
- make a **complaint**.

A **complaint** is telling someone:


- there is a problem
- something is wrong.

We only use your personal information when we need to.

We may share your personal information with:







- advocacy services to assist them with managing your complaint
- other health / government organisations
- law enforcement agencies to:
- make sure the law is being followed
 - o stop a bad situation from getting worse
 - o make a bad situation better.









Advocacy services help you speak up for yourself.

Law enforcement agencies make sure people follow the law.

When we use your personal information we always follow these rules / laws:

- Law
- Privacy Act 2020
- Health Information
 Privacy Code 2020
- our Privacy Statement.

What information we collect



You do not have to give us your personal information to use:

- our website
- information on our website.



Some information is automatically recorded when you use our website such as the:

- search words you use
- pages you look at on the website
- links you click on
- date you visited the website
- time you visited the website.

Call recordings




All calls answered by us are recorded.

Audio / sound recordings of calls are kept for 25 days.

They are deleted after 25 days unless the recording is needed:

• to make sure calls are done well

Cookies are small files that websites put on your computer to remember information when you use them.

- are deleted when you close your browser.

- if you want us to change any of your personal information that we have.






